- * Scrap paper/fabric
- * Scissors
- * Glue stick or PVA glue
- * Coloured textas, pens or pencils

What to do:

1. Gather your materials.

2. Have a look at some different types of homes using the web or books – or take a walk around your neighbourhood. What different types of homes can you see?

3. Think about the different parts on the home that you will make. What kind of windows or door does your home have?

4. Sketch an outline of your house on a piece of scrap paper. Think about the different paper or materials you will use to make these different parts of your house.

5. Cut out the shapes of the different parts of your home.

6. Use glue to stick these on to the box. You can be as imaginative as you like.
