Conditions of entry

To help us ensure the safety of all visitors, and to protect our displays and exhibitions from damage, please observe the following conditions of entry to the Tasmanian Museum and Art Gallery (TMAG):



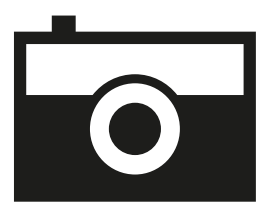
Bags or containers larger than 30cm long are not permitted in the galleries and exhibition areas. Lockers are available in the Visitor Information area.



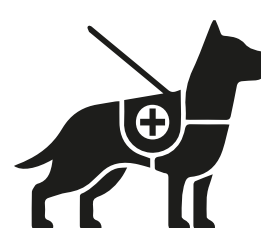
Items that may cause damage to the TMAG collection, including umbrellas, aerosol cans and plant material, must be deposited in the lockers or at the Visitor Information Desk prior to entering the galleries and exhibition areas. However, disability aids may be used to assist access to all public areas of TMAG.



Food and drink are not permitted in the galleries and exhibition areas.



Flash free photography for personal use is permitted unless otherwise indicated. Tripods, selfie sticks or monopods higher than 30cm are not permitted.



Trained or accredited assistance animals are welcome at TMAG when accompanied by their handler. All other animals are prohibited.



Visitors should be aware of their health and safety responsibilities whilst visiting TMAG. All visitors must comply with any reasonable health and safety instructions, and take reasonable care not to put themselves or others at risk. Visitors participating in interactive experiences do so at their own risk. Footwear must be worn at all times.



Security cameras are installed throughout TMAG and may record you during your visit.



TMAG is a smoke-free site.



Visitors should obey all signs regarding accessing, touching and protecting the collections and should not remove, alter or affix anything to TMAG collections and property.



Visitors who do not comply with TMAG notices or who engage in conduct that poses a threat to TMAG buildings or exhibits, or to personal safety, may be directed to leave the premises by an authorised officer.
